- 1) As our Associate Pastor Reverend Tom Tofilon's contract expires on 09/24/2021, we will convene a special congregational meeting on April 18 during which we will vote on whether or not to renew his contract for another 3 years. To assist the congregation in making a decision, the Elder Deacon Board has formed the English Pastor Evaluation Committee to survey church members on Reverend Tofilon's job performance. A survey will be e-mailed to all members later in January. After survey results are received, a summary report will be compiled for review by the congregation. Members may e-mail Deborah Ing at ing.deborah@gmail.com with any questions about the process.
- 2) Praise God, "The Light of Life Church", which has been fully supported by CCCB as a branch worship service of CCCB for more than seven years, with its co-worker's dedicated efforts and preparation, has officially become an independent Church "The Light of Life Christian Church, Inc. (TLOLCC)" in December 2020. According to the decision of EDB in last September, Chinese Christian Church of Baltimore will continue to support partially the new church for two more years. May the Lord greatly use TLOLCC in local gospel ministries.
- 3) According to the orders of the governor and county chief executive, the reopening plan for social gatherings has been postponed. The deacon board decides that all brothers and sisters should stay at home and worship online, except those who must come for the Sunday service. To reduce the risk of infection, please practice safety procedures: wear a mask, wash your hands frequently, and maintain social distancing. The church, fellowship, and congregation maintain close contact, and please inform each other if necessary.
